## **All ELS students are required to bring/have:**

- 2 large boxes of facial tissues and 1 container Lysol type wipes (no bleach)
- supplies, clothing, and lunch boxes labeled
- 1 pack dry erase markers (low odor)
- Home supplies: crayons, pencils, ruler, scissors, glue, and envelopes (for sending \$\$\$ in)
- P.E. - All students: rubber soled/athletic tennis shoes with laces or Velcro (no platform, elevator, boots, sandal, hiking, slip-on etc. shoes); girls- no skirts or dresses  
VI-VIII: school PE uniform (see ELS's Handbook) Available for purchase from school

## **The following items are not permitted:**

- roller bags (book bags must fit in assigned lockers or cubbies), a date or schedule book (assignment books will be provided by ELS), **MECHANICAL PENCILS**, any novelty items (light-up/noise making shoes, white out, erasers, pencils), or any type of adhesive/stretchy covers for books.

## **KINDERGARTEN**

- 1 5-8oz. bottle white school glue
- 4 large white glue sticks
- 1 pk. Crayola/Prang watercolor paints
- 1 (8 pk.) Crayola *washable* markers
- 2 boxes of 24 standard size Crayola crayons
- 1 pair BLUNT edge Fiskar brand scissors
- 1 large parent's long sleeved shirt (please cut off extra arm length to fit your child)
- 1 lunch box (Children must be able to independently open all containers)
- 2 dozen #2 sharpened pencils (not mechanical)
- 1 plastic crayon box/shoe box
- 1 (12-pack) color pencils
- 2 big pink pearl erasers
- 1 pack of Jumbo pencils
- A change of clothes w/underwear & socks

## **GRADE I**

Label child's name on EACH individual pencil, crayon, and marker. Do NOT use paper labels.

- 4 (8-pack) Crayola crayons (**NO CHUBBY**)
- 4 LARGE size glue sticks
- 1 pair BLUNT edge Fiskar brand scissors
- 1 – 4-oz. school glue (white only)
- 2 composition books
- 2 Primary Journals (these have a blank space for pictures and lines for writing) buy early in July

## **GRADE I continued**

- 4 dozen #2 sharpened pencils (not mechanical)
- 2 blue and 1 yellow pocket folders **NO CLIPS** (Please write child's name in upper left corner on front cover)
- 1 (8-pack) Crayola water colors
- 2 pink erasers
- 1 large parent's long sleeved shirt (please cut off extra arm length to fit your child)
- 1 back pack
- 1 lunch box (Children must be able to independently open all containers)

## **GRADE II**

Label child's name on EACH individual pencil, crayon, and marker. Do NOT use paper labels.

- 36 #2 pencils, sharpened (plain, **NO** mechanical) (label @ eraser end)
- 2 pkg 24 crayons
- 1 pkg. Crayola markers (no fine points)
- 1 box colored pencils and sharpener
- 2, solid pink erasers
- smock or old shirt
- 1 single-subject spiral notebook
- 2 composition books
- 3 pocket folders (1 blue, 1 yellow, 1 orange)
- scissors
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 – 5 to 8 oz. bottle white school glue
- 1 – 8 pack Crayola water colors
- Pencil bag or zip-lock; **NO PENCIL BOXES**



## GRADE III

- 1 red spiral with clips
- 5 spirals: single subject (2 blue, 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 black)
- 2 dozen #2 pencils (plain yellow) (NO mechanical)
- 2 solid pink erasers (no novelty types)
- 1 pack of colored pencils, (12 pack ONLY)
- 1 Elmer's glue stick
- 1 pair of sharp pointed scissors
- 2 marble, hard cover composition books- **NO** spirals
- 1 pack (150 count) of loose leaf wide ruled paper with red line margin
- 2 packs Crayola brand crayons (24-pack ONLY)
- 1 smock for art (adult's old shirt, sleeves cut)

## GRADE IV

- 1 orange plastic folder, with pockets AND clips
- 6 spirals: single subject (2 blue, 2 yellow, 1 green, 1 black)
- 2 dozen #2 pencils ( plain, no mechanical)
- 2 solid pink erasers (no novelty types)
- 1 pack of colored pencils, (12 pack ONLY)
- 2 Elmer's glue stick
- 1 pair of sharp pointed scissors
- 2 marble, hard cover composition books- **NO** spirals
- 1 pack (150 count) of loose leaf wide ruled paper with red line margin
- 2 packs Crayola brand crayons (24-pack ONLY)
- 1 pack 8 count Crayola water colors
- Pencil pouch
- 1 smock for art (adult's old shirt, sleeves cut)

## GRADE V

- 2in. binder with 7 tabs
- 2 dozen #2 pencils (plain, **NO mechanical**)
- 2 solid pink erasers
- Blue/Black pens – no RED
- 2 (24-pg) Crayola crayons

- 2 glue sticks
- 1 scissors, sharp point
- 2 packages of loose leaf lined paper
- 6 spiral notebooks: single subject (2 blue, 2 yellow, 1 green, 1 black)
- 1 bound composition book (no spiral)
- 1 – 8 count Crayola water colors
- Art smock
- small thesaurus
- pocket dictionary
- 1 pencil pouch (zipped)

## GRADES VI, VII, VIII ALL MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS

### MATH

- 4 BLUE spiral notebooks (brought to school on first day)
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 2 dozen #2 pencils (plain yellow, **NO** mechanical)

### LITERATURE:

- 1 Composition book
- 1 RED spiral notebook

### ENGLISH:

- 1 YELLOW folder (pockets & clips)
- 1 yellow or orange spiral, 3 subject
- 1 "pocket" dictionary AND thesaurus

### SCIENCE:

- composition book
- 1 GREEN spiral
- 1in. three-ring binder with **7 (seven)** dividers
- colored pencils

### SOCIAL STUDIES:

- 1 BLACK spiral – single subject, to be kept in binder (see below)
- 1 pkg. colored pencils and 1 pkg. crayons

### ART:

- Crayola Watercolor Paints – 8 pack or more

### ALL SUBJECTS:

- black or blue pen **ONLY!**
- loose-leaf paper (**COLLEGE RULED**)
- pencils (plain, **NO MECHANICAL**)
- 1 3-ring binder with **5 (five)** dividers
- 1 purple or multi-colored spiral notebook
- 1 orange spiral notebook
